Regular Monthly Meeting
June 13th, 2019 at 7:00pm

The regular monthly meeting was held on June 13th, 2019 at the Richard A. Papa Office Building, 2-4 Park St. Fonda NY 12068.

Present: Supervisor Edward Bishop, Councilmen: Janet Tyler, Anthony Bruno, William Smith and Matt Paton Also present, William Holvig, Supt. of Highways, and Stella Gittle Sole Assessor. Town Attorney Robert Kruger and Kimberly M. Sullivan, Town Clerk were excused.

A motion to approve the minutes of the 05/09/2019 Regular Meeting was made by Smith and seconded by Bruno. All present voting in favor, motion carried.

4. NYS Dept. of Tax and Finance reported our Final State Equalization Rate is 92%

Report from the Highway Superintendent as follows:

1. The dead ends have been prepped for paving and ditching is complete.
2. The state reduced the Pave NY budget by \$14,000 but may be restored.
3. The paving slated for this year may go over budget slightly; the board gave approval to take from Fund Balance if necessary.

4. Bill attended school in Ithaca, they covered many topics and the new truck is at Prime Signs for lettering.
5. Dave Bouck passed away this week and was always here to help lend a hand if needed.

Stella Gittle, Sole Assessor reported 6 applications to the BAR were received and 2 assessments were lowered.

A motion to appoint Robert House to a new five year term as a member of the Town of Mohawk Planning Bard was made by Tyler and seconded by Paton. All present voting in favor, motion passed.

Ed Bishop gave an update on the Conti Solar project; Mitch Cline and John Ervin were in attendance. The application has been received and accepted by the Planning Board. We had a very informative meeting with NYSERDA. The Planning Board will meet next Tuesday and will present a resolution asking to be Lead Agency, they then have to wait 30 days for replies

Resolution #028 authorizing the Supervisor, Town Board and Highway Superintendent to audit and pay bills was made by a motion from Smith and seconded by Paton. All present voting in favor, motion passed.
